The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No.638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer in this application is for setting aside the impugned order of the respondent dated 12.09.2022. The concerned respondent has passed a reasoned order in compliance to this Tribunal's order in O.A. 139 of 2022 on 27.07.2022. In this direction, the respondents were advised to review the order of suspension and communicate its decision to the applicant. It appears from the reasoned order passed on 12.09.2022, the respondent reviewed the earlier order of suspension of the applicant and enhanced the subsistence allowance. The respondent also recorded that since the criminal case is still continuing against her, the prayer of revocation of her suspension cannot be considered at this stage.

After hearing the submissions of the learned counsels and examining the records, the Tribunal does not find it appropriate to set aside the reasoned order passed on 12.09.2022 in terms of this Tribunal's own direction given to the respondent on 27.07.2022. It is evident from the reasoned order that the respondent has complied and reviewed the suspension order. Hence, this application is disposed of without any orders.
