The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020, issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Affidavit of service filed by the applicant is kept on record.

Counsel for the applicant has prayed for leave to add the Secretary, Department of Agriculture as respondent no. 1 (a). Prayer is allowed.

The instant application has been filed mainly praying for a direction upon the respondents to consider the case of the applicant for compassionate appointment. As per the applicant, his father died on 03.03.2018 (Annexure A-2). Subsequently, the applicant submitted application for compassionate appointment on 03.07.2018 and 21.07.2018 (Annexure A-5). Therefore, one enquiry committee was formed vide Memo. dated 23.10.2019 (Annexure A-9). However, till date no decision has been communicated to him.

As per the applicant, since he is passing through acute financial crisis, his purpose would be served if the respondent no. 1 (a) i.e. Secretary, Department of Agriculture would be directed to take final decision with regard to the compassionate appointment within a stipulated period of time.

Mr. M.N. Roy, counsel for the respondent has submitted that they have no objection to take final decision with regard to the compassionate appointment of the applicant if so directed.
