The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 496-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application, Badal Chandra Dey, the applicant, a GDA attached to R.T.U., OPD Department, SSKM Hospital, Kolkata and who has superannuated on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2019, has prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under:

- "....(i) To direct the respondent No. 3 herein to take necessary steps to withdraw and/or cancel/set aside the said reason order dated 24.12.2019 passed by the respondent no. 3 herein.
- (ii) To direct the respondent No. 3 to take necessary steps to re-hear the said matter in presence of all the necessary parties and to pass a reason order afresh."

At the very outset, it is submitted by Mr. G. Ghosh, learned advocate for the private respondent no. 6, that a suit, being T.S. 27 of 2020, has been filed by his client against the applicant herein, praying for a declaration that she is the legally married wife of Badal Chandra Dey. A copy of the plaint is filed today. Let it be kept on record.

Mr. A. Dalai, learned advocate for the applicant submits that the order under challenge may be set aside and quashed as it has been passed without
