The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The prayer in this application is for a direction to take final decision regarding full pensionary benefits to the applicant. The representation of the applicant was also considered and disposed of by the respondents in the Department of Land & Land Reforms on 09.03.2018. In the said order, the applicant was communicated that since his service was on temporary basis, having worked only four months in a year as Tehsil Mohurrier from 1973 to 1984, therefore, his prayer for full pension could not be accepted. The length of service rendered by the applicant after being regularised in the post of Group-D since 08.07.2002 is only 14 years and six months.

Learned counsel for the applicant does not dispute the length of service rendered by the applicant, however, his submission is for a direction to the respondent to reconsider his representation for full pension.

Since the respondent had already passed a reasoned

order and communicated the same to the applicant, the question of directing the respondent to reconsider and pass any reasoned order is not necessary.

Having heard the learned counsels and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of without any orders.
