The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020, 456-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 16th July, 2021 and 586-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 31.08.2021 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (6) of Section 5 of The Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed praying for a direction upon the authority to provide compassionate appointment to the applicant.

As per the applicant, her father died in the year 11.05.1999 and subsequently her mother applied for compassionate appointment on behalf of her daughter on 15.12.1999. Thereafter on 26.08.2018 (Annexure-C) the Deputy Director of Industrial Training, in charge of I T I, Howrah vide his letter to the Director of Industrial Training, Technical Education and Skill Development Deptt. had asked for consideration. However, till date no final decision has been communicated to her. Being aggrieved with, she has filed the instant application.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice her purpose, if the respondents would be directed to take final decision with regard to her compassionate appointment within a stipulated period of time.
