The present application in terms of section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 inter alia praying for an order for quashing the order dated 13.03.2020 passed by the Respondent No. 2 whereby the prayer for compassionate appointment has been rejected as fully stated in the application has been filed to secure redressal of grievances.
