The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of both the parties, matter has been taken up.

Heard the parties. It is noted that the different departments are taking different stand with regard to compassionate appointment of wards, who worked in different Work Charged Establishments. Some cases it has been noticed that different department has allowed compassionate appointment to the wards of the deceased employee of different Work Charged Establishment, on the other hand in some cases, different department are rejecting the claim of the applicant on the ground that their father/mother since worked in Work Charged Establishments. Therefore, the Government is directed to clear their stand with regard to compassionate appointment of wards of deceased Work Charged employees. However, counsel for the applicant has submitted that he wants to file one supplementary affidavit with regard to original application. Prayer is allowed. Let the matter be listed for hearing on **19.07.2022**. Reply/rejoinder, if any, in the meantime.
