The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (6) of section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application, the applicant has prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under :-

10. (a) *“Directing the respondent authorities particularly the respondent nos. 2 to 10 to consider the name of the petitioner for promotion for the post of Company Havilder Major and fix all consequential service benefits following the fifty-point roster prescribed under the West Bengal Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribe (reservation of Vacancies in Service and Promotion) Act, 1976.”*

It is submitted by Mr. S. N. Ray, learned advocate for the applicant, that the Commandant, West Bengal Civil Emergency Force, Government of West Bengal –the respondent no. 7, may be directed to consider the representation dated 19th June, 2019, collectively marked as annexure B to the application, for considering the prayer of the applicant for promotion to the post of Company Havilder Major.

Mr. M. N. Roy, learned advocate for the State respondents submits, if directed, the respondent no. 7 shall consider the matter in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned advocates for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the application is disposed of by
