The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated $23^{\text {rd }}$ November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned counsel has filed a copy of Memo. No. 4234 dated 03.12.2023. A copy has been served upon Mr.A.Felix. By this Memo. a calculation sheet has been annexed showing total monthly income of family at Rs. 30,288/- with the remarks - the total family income of the applicant exceeds $90 \%$ of the gross salary last drawn by the deceased employee, which was Rs. 11,460/-. Earlier on 27.02.2023 the respondent authority had regretted the applicant's prayer for employment under compassionate ground giving the reason that the monthly income of the family is more than the qualifying amount. Mr.Felix, having received a copy of this Memo. with the calculation sheet, wishes to examine it closely and if necessary, file an exception to it.
