The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

From the submissions of the learned counsels and the records it has been revealed that these applicants who had approached this Tribunal in OA-170 of 2021 in the case of Nuton Biswas & Ors. Vs.
