The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020, issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The counsel for the applicant has prayed for leave to make appropriate amendment with regard to the respondent no. 1. Prayer is allowed.

The instant applicant has been filed praying for a direction upon the respondent authority to consider his case for compassionate appointment. According to the applicant, his father died on 25.01.2014. Thereafter, he made an application for compassionate appointment to the respondents in the year 2014 itself. However, till date no final decision has been communicated to him.

The counsel for the respondents however has submitted that his case is under active consideration and the credentials of the educational qualification of the applicant has been sent for verification purpose. Therefore, the respondents are under process of taking final decision.

During the course of the hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice his purpose if the respondent no. 1, Additional Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal, Department of Home and Hill Affairs be directed to take final decision with regard to the compassionate appointment of the applicant and communicate the same.
