In this application, the applicant prays for consideration of his case for compassionate employment considering his overall educational qualification. The application for compassionate employment was not considered by the respondent authorities earlier. The respondent authorities refused consideration of this matter on the ground that the educational certificate submitted by him proved to be false. Subsequently, an FIR was also lodged under appropriate law against the applicant for providing false certificate.

Mr. G. P. Banerjee, learned advocate for the State respondents submits that not only the certificate approved to be false but also the dates of the two certificates, one from Krishnaganj Anil Smriti High School, P.O.- Krishnaganj, Dist.-Nadia and another from Mahatma Gandhi Secondary & Sr Secondary Education, Delhi, appears to be unrealistic. In the first school, the year 2002 is shown when he was a student in class-X, whereas in the other school, Mahatma Gandhi Secondary & Sr Secondary Education, shows 2014 as the year he is supposed to have passed the secondary education examination.

Submission of the learned advocate for the applicant is that his overall qualification of the applicant may be considered.

After hearing both the learned advocates and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court does not find any merit in directing the respondent to consider the case of this applicant for

compassionate employment. From the records and submissions of the respondent, it is evident that prima facie this is a case of submission of false or doubtful certificate of education. It is clear that the State authorities enquired in detail and found the certificates to be false and a FIR was also lodged. The Court finds the case is not maintainable. Hence, the case is dismissed.

Accordingly, the matter is disposed of.
