In the instant application, Smt. Keya Majumdar - the applicant, has prayed for compassionate employment as her deceased husband Late Sujoy Majumdar died-in-harness as Police Constable attached to Howrah G. R. P (Government Railway Police) on 06.11.2013. Very soon after the death on 27.11.2013, the applicant – Smt. Keya Majumdar applied for a compassionate employment before the authorities. The respondents asked her to provide various relevant documents to establish her claim as the legally wife of the deceased employee. In response the applicant submitted all her documents including a decree by the Civil Court pronouncing her to be the legally married wife of the said deceased employee Late Sujoy Majumdar.

Learned advocate for the applicant submits that suitable direction may be given to the respondents to dispose of her application at the earliest.

Learned advocate for the State submits that if such direction is given, the respondents will consider her application as per law.

Having heard the learned advocates and after perusing the records, the Superintendent of Police, Government Railway Police, Howrah – the respondent no. 3 is hereby directed that the application for compassionate employment in the name of Smt. Keya Majumder should
