The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949 - WBAT / 2J - 15 / 2016 dated 24.12.2020 and 456-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 16^{th} July, 2021 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section 6(5) of the Administrative Tribunal's Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed mainly praying for a direction upon the respondents authority to give an appointment on compassionate ground to the applicant. As per the applicant, his father died on 16.07.2019 at the age of 54 years leaving behind his two sons and widow. The younger son has applied for compassionate appointment on 16.08.2019 before the Executive Engineer with a reminder dated 17.12.2019. However, till date, no decision has been communicated to the applicant. As per the applicant, he has acute financial crisis. It would suffice his purpose if the respondent authority would be directed to take a final decision with regard to the compassionate appointment of the applicant within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the respondent has no objection if the authority would be directed to take final decision in accordance with Law and Rules.
