The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 536-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985

In this application the applicant has prayed for a direction to the respondent to consider his case of compassionate employment. Mrs. Agarwal submits that the deceased employee died on 25.11.2000 and on 27.02.2001 the mother had submitted a plain paper application on behalf of the applicant. Later, the applicant himself submitted the proforma application to the respondents. Since then, the applicant has been submitting representations to the respondent enquiring about the fate of his case for compassionate employment. The last such representation appears to have been submitted on 08.12.2021 appearing at page 31 of this application.

Ms. Banerjee submits that if a direction is given to the respondent to consider and dispose of the application as per law, it will be complied.

After hearing both the learned advocates, the application is disposed of by directing the Director of Agriculture, Govt. of

West Bengal, Respondent No. 2 (iii) to dispose of this application for compassionate employment within a period of sixteen weeks from the date of this order to be obtained from the Website of the Tribunal. The reasoned order shall also be communicated to the applicant within one week thereafter.

Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
