The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt. – II) dated 23^{rd} November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsel for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

As is evident from the past dates, the applicant had been praying for accommodation on every single date of hearing. By an order dated 5.5.2022, the Tribunal had directed the applicant to satisfy on the point of limitation with documentary support. Since then the applicant prayed for "One more chance" to satisfy the Court on the point of limitation. On the next date - 02.8.2022, the applicant again prayed for accommodation. On the next date - 12.8.2022, the applicant prayed again for one accommodation to satisfy the court on the point of limitation. Again on 16.9.2022, the applicant prayed for one more accommodation to satisfy the Court on the point of limitation. Again on 16.9.2022, the applicant prayed for one more accommodation to satisfy the Court on the point of limitation. Again on 10.11.2022, one more such accommodation was prayed. On 12.12.2022 one such accommodation was given as a last chance to the applicant.

From the above facts, the Tribunal has come to this conclusion that the applicant has prayed for too many accommodations without any reason since the
