The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (6) of section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Affidavit of service filed by kept on record.

In this application Sankar Prasad Mondal, the applicant has prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under :-

*“.....(a) An order do issue directing the respondent authorities to forthwith grant pension and arrear pension after condoning the shortfall in qualifying service taking into account the past service rendered by him under respondent no. 4 as “National Volunteer Force” from 11.06.1984 to 15.11.2007, within a stipulated time period after considering the Order/Judgment dated 23.07.2014 passed in WPST 379 of 2013 with WPST 503 of 2013 by the Hon’ble High Court, Calcutta (Annexure-“D” in the instant Original Application).*

*(b) An order do issue directing the respondent authorities to dispose and pass a reason and speaking order pertaining to the representation dated 22.07.2019 in accordance with law after giving an opportunity of hearing to the applicant.*

*(c) An order do issue directing the respondent authorities to forthwith grant pension and arrear pension and other consequential*

*benefits arising thereto @ 18% p.a. till the actual date of realization of the same....”*

It appears that the applicant prior to joining the West Bengal Police as constable served as National Volunteer Force from 11<sup>th</sup> June, 1984 to 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2007. After being selected, the applicant joined the post of constable on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2007 and had superannuated on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2017 after nine years two months fifteen days of service in the post of constable. Though the applicant has received gratuity and lump sum leave salary, however pension has not been granted for non-completion of the statutory period for grant of pension. Submission is as the service rendered as constable was in continuation of his service in the National Volunteer Force, the respondents may be directed to take the entire period of service from 11<sup>th</sup> June, 1984 till 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2017 as one unit. Accordingly, he is entitled to pension in accordance with law. In support of his submission, Mr. S. Ghosh, learned advocate for the applicant, has relied on the judgement passed on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2014 in W.P.S.T. 379 of 2013 Anantalal Mahata – versus-State of West Bengal & Ors. It is submitted since representation dated 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2019, being annexure “C” to the application has been filed, appropriate order may be passed for consideration of the same.

Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the State respondents submits, if directed, the respondent authorities will consider the said representation in accordance with law.

Mr. B. Mitra, the departmental representative for the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal adopts the submission of Mr.
