Mr. Haldar is not pressing prayers 8.(a), (b), (d) and (e). The prayer 8(c) is praying for a direction to the concerned respondent authorities to pay the family pension to the applicant in terms of memo No.732-F(Pen) dated 12.11.2008. The applicant is the unmarried daughter of the deceased employee Saila Mohan Dutta, who had served under the Department of Land and Land Reforms as a Revenue Inspector. From the submissions it is understood that the absence period of the deceased employee and applicant's father from 03.08.1976 to 30.12.1984 is to be regularised. As explained by Ms. Sarkar, the Department has initiated steps for regularisation of this absent period which will require the approval of the Finance Department as well.

Heard the learned counsels.
