The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed challenging the Second Show Cause Notice dated 08.05.2019 and also to pray for a direction to make payment of retiral benefits.

During the pendency of the instant application, the respondents have provided provisional pension to the applicant as per direction of this Tribunal. However, as per the applicant, till date she has not received G.P.F., G.I.S. and Leave encashment.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that she had already submitted reply to the Second Show Cause Notice, however, no final order has been passed till date. Therefore, presently it would suffice her purpose, if the Disciplinary Authority would be directed to pass final order considering her reply to the Second Show Cause Notice within a stipulated period of time.

It has been further submitted that in the interim the Respondents are directed to make payment of G.P.F., G.I.S., and Leave Encashment and other retiral dues, if any, to the applicant.

The counsel for the respondent has submitted that they have no objection to make payment of admissible retiral dues as per rules subject to fulfilment of criteria in this regard as per rules.

In view of the above, the Disciplinary Authority is directed to conclude the Departmental Proceedings and communicate their decision by way of passing a speaking and reasoned order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of this order. In the interim, the respondents are directed to make payment admissible retiral dues to the applicant within a period of four weeks. Both the parties are directed to cooperate with each other in this regard as per rules. Accordingly, OA is disposed of with the above observation and direction with no order as to costs.
