The instant application has been filed praying for a direction upon the respondent authorities to enhance the remuneration of the applicant in terms of Memo No. 4011- F(P) dated 20.05.2013 and Memo No. 1107-F(P) dated 25.02.2016 as he is working more than twenty years.

According to the counsel for the applicant, the applicant has made a representation before the authority for such enhancement on 30.10.2017 with reminder dated 21.12.2018, which was received by the authority on 07.02.2019. However, till date neither his representation has been considered nor his remuneration has been enhanced.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has fairly submitted that it would suffice his purpose if the Respondent No. 3, Director and Ex-officio Secretary, Agriculture Department be directed to consider the case of the applicant as per the aforementioned circulars within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the respondent has no objection for such consideration as per rules and circulars of the department.

Heard the parties and perused the records.

In view of the above, the Director & Ex-officio Secretary, Agriculture Department is directed to consider the case of the applicant in terms of Memo No. 4011-F(P) dated 20.05.2013 & Memo No. 1107-F(P) dated 25.02.2016 and to take decision and communicate the same by way of reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of

receipt of the order if the applicant would be found eligible for such benefit in the aforementioned Memos and he may be paid the said amount immediately. However, we have made it clear that we have not observed anything on the merit of the case. Accordingly, OA is disposed of with no order as to costs.
