The instant application has been filed by the wife of the concerned employee who did not receive any pension or pensionary benefits during her lifetime due to disputed scale of pay. However, concerned employee had made representation along with the other similarly circumstanced employees before the authority and one of the effected party also approached this Tribunal for extension of NISG benefit. However, according to the counsel for the applicant, the same issue is still pending before the Hon'ble Apex Court.

However, the husband of the applicant never got any pensionary benefit, even the applicant is not getting pension or pensionary benefits till date, therefore, the counsel for the applicant has fairly submitted that his client has prayed for making detailed representation before the authority for asking of pension and other pensionary benefits as well as arrears thereof on the undisputed pay scale and if the authority be directed to consider her case within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the respondent has no objection to consider such application if it would be filed by the applicant.

In view of the above, the applicant is directed to make detailed representation before the respondent no. 2 and the respondent no. 2 is directed to consider the case of the applicant treating the OA as a part of it and to take final decision and communicate the same by way of reasoned and
