Today the parties have submitted that there were some inadvertent typographical error in the order dated 05.10.2021, which is as follows:

In line one of the paragraph two of page 1, it is typed as **posed** instead of **posted**. In the fifteenth line of first paragraph of page 2, it has been typed as **goes** in place of **gives**. Therefore they have submitted that necessary correction may be made.
