The matter is taken up pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 536-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 and the Rules framed thereunder.

In terms of the previous order, an affidavit of service filed today be kept on record. It appears from the affidavit of service that the respondent No. 1 has been served by hand on 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2022 whereas, the remaining respondents were served by registered post on 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2022. In respect of respondent Nos. 3 and 4, the notices have been delivered on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2022 as per delivery status reports downloaded from the official website of India Post.

So far as the service of notices upon the respondent Nos. 2 and 5, no acknowledgement in respect of service of notice has been filed. However, more than 40 days are over from the date of posting, for which, it can be safely presumed that the notice of the case has been served upon the said respondents in terms of section 27 of the General Clauses Act, 1987.

Considering the aforesaid facts, the service of notice upon the State respondents has been made satisfactorily in terms of Rule 11 (1) of the West Bengal Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1994.

Despite repeated calls, none appears for the State respondents.
