In compliance with the previous order, an affidavit of service filed today be kept on record.

It appears from the affidavit of service that the copy of the application has been served by post and the same has been delivered on the addressees / respondents herein between 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 and 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2022. Accordingly, the service of notice upon the respondents is completed.

On repeated calls, none appears for the State respondents. Mr. D. Koley, learned Panel Pleader present in court is requested to represent the State respondents. A copy of the application is handed over and the same is acknowledged by Mr. D. Koley, learned counsel in open court.

It appears from the materials on record that the dependant of the employee is not getting pension due to loss of the service book of the employee namely Biswapati Saha, the then Superintendent Engineer, P.W.D. Burdwan who retired from service on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 1994. As the dispute is pending for a considerable period of time, and considering the nature of relief, it is a fit case to be referred to the National Lok Adalat on 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 for disposal.

However, Mr. D. Koley is directed to obtain instruction from the Department in this regard and inform the Court regarding the present status of family pension / retiral benefits of the deceased employee on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.
