It appears from the submissions of the learned counsels and records of this application that the deceased though initially nominated the applicant in the service papers, but due to unknown reasons, he did not fill up the name of his wife, the applicant as his nominee at the time of his superannuation. In this regard, the applicant has furnished a representation before the Director, Department of Consumer Affairs praying for family pension.

Appearing on behalf of the applicant, Ms.J.Ray, learned counsel submits that the applicant is the only legally wedded wife of the

deceased employee and lived a harmonious married life with the deceased husband. During their marriage, no case was filed against her spouse relating to any marital discord.

Appearing on behalf of the State respondents, Mr.S.K.Mondal, learned counsel submits that the office records have to be checked to ascertain whether she is the legal heir of the deceased employee and based on relevant documents, the respondents will come to a decision.

Appearing on behalf of the Principal Accountant General (A&E) West Bengal, Mr.B.Mitra, informs that at present, no such family pension proposal is pending with them.

The matter is admitted. Let the matter appear under the heading "For Orders" on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.
