In this application, Ajoy Kumar Sahoo, the applicant has prayed for disbursement of arrear pension along with interest and for payment of interest for delayed payment of gratuity after condoning the shortfall of service of six months nineteen days for getting pension.

Heard learned advocates for the parties.

We find that the issue is covered by the judgement delivered on 18th January, 2022 passed in WP.ST 91 of 2019 (Sudhansu Karmakar and others – vs- State of West Bengal and others) wherein, interalia, it has been held as under:-

"....Admittedly, the power to relax the period for the purpose of qualifying service is provided in DCRB Rules, 1971 but with an outer cap of six months. The authorities cannot act in contravention to the statutory provisions nor the Writ Court should issue a Mandamus commanding the authorities to act in clear violation of the statutory provisions. Once the power of relaxation is brindled with an outer cap, the authorities are denuded of power to extend such relaxation, who do not come within the purview thereof...".
