In this application, the applicant had applied for a compassionate employment which was considered and rejected by the respondent. Therefore, in this OA 885 of 2017, the applicant had approached this Tribunal for relief. The Tribunal after considering the application directed the respondents to complete the entire exercise in connection with the compassionate appointment of the applicant within a period of twelve weeks.

In compliance with this order, the respondent considered his application and issued a detailed reasoned order on 5.7.2018 giving reasons for rejection of the application

Mr. Halder submits that suitable direction may be given to the respondents to reconsider his reasoned order.

Mr. Roy, learned advocate appearing for the respondents however, submits that the respondents have on two occasions thoroughly examined the application and found that the applicant is not eligible for compassionate appointment under any Rule. Thus, the application was rejected and the applicant was intimated. Therefore, further direction to the respondents will be a useless exercise. The matter may be dismissed.

I agree with the respondents and the respondents had issued reasoned order. I do not find any merit in this application and I cannot direct the respondents to re-consider the application which was earlier done by this Tribunal in another OA. Accordingly, OA is dismissed.
