The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Mr. M. N. Roy, learned counsel contends that this application is not maintainable for the following two reasons :-

1. The applicant did not file any before the statutory Appellate Authority within the permissible time of 37 days.
2. Challenging the final order passed in the Disciplinary Proceedings on 31.01.20215 before this Tribunal today is barred by limitation.

Mr. Chatterjee, learned counsel has submitted that due to illness of the applicant, he could not prefer any appeal before the Appellate Authority.

After examination of the documents, the Tribunal is satisfied that the applicant had failed to seek remedy against the final order before the Appellate Authority within the permissible time. Further, such final order passed on 31.01.2015 is being assailed before this Tribunal by filing this application on 10.12.2024. The application not being maintainable is dismissed.

The application is disposed of.
