Heard the learned advocates.

The applicant no.1, Sunil Kumar Das, son-in-law of deceased Indrani Biswas, has in the application prayed for certain benefits, relevant portion of which is as under:

> (a) "release the death-cum-retired benefit of the deceased employee"......

The applicant has also served a legal notice to the State claiming retiral benefits as he is the only successor of the deceased employee, Indrani Biswas. Learned advocate for the applicant submits that despite submission of the representation, the State respondent has not taken any action so far.

Learned advocate for the State, Mr. Gautam Pathak Banerjee submits that as the son-in-law of the deceased Indrani Biswas he is not entitled for either family pension or death gratuity as per the Section 7 (1) (e) (1) and (2) of the West Bengal Services (Death-cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules, 1971. He is only entitled for release of G.P.F., Group Insurance of the deceased Indrani Biswas, if found eligible.
