The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

At the very outset, Mr. T. Chattopadhyay, learned counsel presents a copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in WPST 48 of 2023. Mr. Chattopadhyay refers to the specific part of the order which is, *“Since the final relief has been granted by us in the writ-petition, the proceeding before the Tribunal is rendered infructuous and liberty is granted to the parties to approach the Tribunal for passing a formal order.”*

Submission of Mr. Chattopadhyay, which is also endorsed by learned counsels and the learned departmental representatives is that in view of the above order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, this matter in this Tribunal has become infructuous, therefore, it may be disposed of.

In view of the above facts and submissions, the Tribunal disposes of this application without passing any order.
