In this application the applicant Pushpa Rani Majhi and Ananda Majhi the mother and son have applied for compassionate employment after the death of Madhusudan Majhi, Bonoshramik on 09.03.2000. It appears from the record that within the time limit, the wife of deceased employee has applied for compassionate employment on a plain paper. Against this application, the respondents had advised her to appear before the enquiry committee with all relevant documents. However, Puspa Rani Majhi, the wife of the deceased employee decides not to proceed with her application for employment, rather she prays for her son Ananda Majhi as an applicant for compassionate employment.

Thereafter, after considering the application of Ananda Majhi, the son of the deceased employee, respondents issued an order dated 18.05.2015 in which the application of Ananda Majhi for compassionate employment was rejected with the following reasons :-

“Applied 12 years after death of his father when he attained majority, need for immediate relief is not justified and it attracts restriction of scheme guidelines”.

The applicant then approached this Tribunal challenging the above impugned order and praying for setting it aside. It appears that the applicant has approached this Tribunal after a lapse of six years. The question of determination is to be decided.

Mrs. Mitra appears for the state respondents. None appeared for the petitioner. Let the matter appear under the heading “Orders” on **21.09.2022.**
