The Status Report also states that the applicant is otherwise eligible. Let the Status Report be kept on record.

Since the Status Report has presented a clear picture and the case for consideration of his application will be taken up when his turn comes, the Tribunal comes to a conclusion that no order is required to be passed in this application.
