The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the notification no.949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-Section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Affidavit of service filed today be kept on record. In view of the urgency the matter is taken up for hearing under the heading “New Application”.

In this application, the applicant, Sankar Mondal, a Medical Technologist (P&O), Gr-III at Government Hospital on contractual basis, has prayed for a certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under:

“(a) A writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondents including the Respondent authorities particularly the Respondent no.3 i.e. The Secretary and Controller of Examinations, West Bengal Health Recruitment Board and his men and agents to allow the petitioner to participate in the selection process for the post of the Medical Technologist (P&O), Gr-III by submitting the online application before 06.02.2021 in terms of Advertisement dated 21.01.2021 upon condonation of age bar;”

It is submitted by Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant, that in view of the law laid down in Gobinda Chandra Mondal Vs. Principal, Rabindra Mahavidyalaya; 2013 (1) CHN (CAL) 9, particularly in paragraph 25 thereof, the applicant is entitled to participate in the selection process after condoning the age bar and interim order may be passed as the last date for filing online application is 6th February, 2021.

Mr. S. Ghosh, learned advocate for the State respondent submits that since the applicant is already over aged and the age may be relaxable by five years for exceptionally qualified person which the applicant has not been able to demonstrate in the application, no interim order may be passed. Submission is the issue in Gobinda Chandra Mondal (supra) is different from the question involved in this case. In this regard, he has relied on the judgement passed on 23rd July, 2018 in W.P.S.T. No. 53 of 2018; The Chairman, Public Service Commission, West Bengal Vs. Palash Kumar Samanta & Ors. wherein it has been held that age bar cannot be condoned.

Heard learned advocates for the parties. In view of the statements made in paragraph F (12) and in ground III of the application and since the last date for submission of online application for the post of Medical Technologist (P&O), Gr-III in the West Bengal Health Service is 6th February, 2021, in my view a prima facie case has been made out for passing an interim order. Therefore, let there be an interim order directing the respondents to allow the applicant to submit an application for the posts of Medical Technologist (P and O) Gr-III in the West Bengal Health Service in hard copy format without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties and subject to the final order that may be passed. If the selection process is undertaken, the applicant will be allowed to participate, however, the mark sheet and answer script shall be kept in sealed cover and the result shall not be published without the leave of the Tribunal. It is made clear that this order will not create equity in favour of the applicants.
