In this application, the applicant Bithi Chakraborty whose father Shibtosha Chakraborty died in harness on 10.08.2014 while working with Uttar Dinajpur District Police Force. After the death of the applicant, the mother of applicant submitted a prayer for compassionate employment for her daughter to the post of L.D.C. Thereafter three Mens' Screening –cum- Enquiry Committee was set up and submitted their report. A computer test of the applicant as a candidature was also conducted in which the applicant passed the test.

Thereafter respondents issued a letter the applicant stating that her application for job on compassionate ground for the post of L.D.C. is not being considered at present due the lack of vacancy. The S.P. Uttar Dinajpur in a letter addressed to C.I.D., Bhawani Bhavan, Alipore recommends the candidature of the applicant in the police department. The C.I.D., Bhawani Bhavan, also writes to the Chief Secretary recommending the candidature of the applicant in the Police Department. Therefore, the applicant submits before this Tribunal for issuing a suitable direction to the respondents to offer her job on compassionate ground.
