Vakalatnama filed by the learned advocae be kept on record.

In this application, the applicant Bithi Chakraborty father Shibtosch Chakraborty died in harness on 10.08.2014 while working with Uttar Dinajpur District Police Force. After the death of the employee, the mother of the applicant submitted a prayer for compassionate employment for her daughter to the post of L.D.C. Thereafter three Mens' Screening –cum-Enquiry Committee was set up and submitted their report. A computer test of the applicant as a candidature was also conducted in which the applicant passed the test.

Thereafter respondents issued a letter to the applicant stating that her application for job on compassionate ground for the post of L.D.C. is not being considered at present due the lack of vacancy. As stated in the letter, since her position is Serial 295 in the list her case will be considered when her turn comes.

In view of the above, the applicant submits before this Tribunal for issuing a suitable direction to the respondents to offer her job on compassionate ground expeditiously.

After hearing both the learned advocates, the matter is

disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 1, Addl. Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Department to dispose of the application for compassionate employment as per law and as per vacancy.

Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
