The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly

The instant application prays for a direction to the respondent to issue pension order on behalf of the applicant. Learned counsel for the applicant refers to page 20 in the application which is a representation before the respondents for condonation of shortfall of service of around six months to qualify him for pension.

Mr. Sanyal submits that it will suffice if such a direction is given to the respondent to consider the representation and dispose of the same.

Ms. Sarkar and her colleagues submit that if such a direction is given, the same will be considered by the respondent as per law.

After hearing the learned counsels, the matter is disposed of by directing Respondent 2(i) Secretary, Land & Land
