The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application, Lipika Dutta, the applicant had prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under:

"(a) A direction do issue, directing the respondent no. 5, 6 and 7 to release the interest on delayed payment of retiral dues in favour of your applicant of the deceased employee namely Swapna Dutta from the next date of retirement to the date of actual payment along with interest at the rate of 12% p.a. being Annexure "E"."

It is submitted by Mr.G.Malik, learned advocate for the applicant that as she has received 50 % of the retiral benefits of Swapna Dutta, the deceased employee, prayer is for grant of interest as evident from the representation dated 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 appearing at page 29 of the application.
