In this application the prayer is for a direction to the respondent to condone the deficiency of service of the applicant so that he becomes eligible for getting minimum pension.

The matter was earlier heard by the Tribunal and a direction was issued to the respondent, Addl. Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Deptt. to dispose of the matter after giving an opportunity of hearing within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the presentation of the order. Subsequently the respondent had served notice to the applicant to appear before the authority on 10.02.2020 with all service documents.

Mrs. Mitra submits although the applicant appeared on the scheduled date but since then there has been no development from the side of the respondents regarding his case. Submission is that a direction be given to consider the applicant's application which was duly considered by the Tribunal in OA-176 of 2019.

After having heard the learned advocates, the matter is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 1, Addl. Chief Secretary, Home & Hill Affairs Deptt. to pass a reasoned order within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of this order

and decision to be communicated to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter. Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
