Today, the counsel for the state respondent has raised objection to the effect that this matter should be heard by the Division Bench as on earlier occasion, i.e. on 24.02.2022 though he was not personally present and some other lawyers had asked for adjournment, however, this Bench had recorded that none appears for the respondents. It has been submitted that the matter was earlier heard by the Division Bench and was put before this Single Bench on 24.02.2022.

However, as the counsel for the respondent does not want to be heard by this Single Bench, therefore, this Single Bench is releasing the matter from this Single Bench.
