The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No.638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

Mr. Saurav Bhattacharjee, learned counsel prays for adjournment on behalf of Mrs. Sunita Agarwal, learned counsel for the respondents.

The applicant, being the daughter of the deceased Kanan Bauri, had applied for employment under compassionate ground. The deceased employee had worked as a 'Banashramik' under the Divisional Forest Officer, Bankura (North) Division, who died in harness on 15.03.2014.

Mr. Saurav Nandi, learned counsel for the applicant submits despite several applications, the respondent authorities have not considered her application for such employment. Earlier the applicant's mother had filed a representation praying for such employment.

After hearing submission of Mr. Nandi, this application is disposed of by directing the respondent No.4, the Divisional Forest Officer, Bankura (North) Division to consider the application for employment under compassionate ground dated 05.09.2023 and dispose of the same as per Rules within a period of twelve weeks after passing a speaking and reasoned order. While considering the prayer, the applicant may be advised to appear in person with all relevant documents. The same respondent will also examine the documents and if satisfied with the eligibility for such employment, a proposal may be submitted to the higher authorities. The applicant is also directed to appear in person before the respondent 4 with all relevant documents, if so advised by the respondent.
