In the application, Padma Rani Sardar, - wife of Late Jadu Nath Sardar, an Assistant Commercial Tax Officer, who had expired on 30th September, 2011 leaving behind his wife, the applicant, two sons namely Tarun Sardar and Tusar Sardar and daughter Bula Sardar, has prayed for grant of family pension with effect from October, 2011.

Mr. D. Karan, learned advocate for the applicant submits that since the issue regarding grant of family pension is pending since 2011 appropriate order, as prayed for, may be passed. Submission is that the matter may be disposed of by directing authorities to pass an order for grant of family pension upon perusal of records.

Mr. S.N. Ray, learned advocate for the State respondents submits, if directed, the State authorities will consider the matter in accordance with law.

Mr. B.Mitra, the departmental representative on behalf of the Senior Accounts Officer, office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Government of West Bengal, Kolkata the respondent no. 2(g) submits that the matter regarding grant of family pension was considered by the department and was sent to the office of the Accountant General. However, the records were returned as the service book was incomplete.

Having heard the learned advocates for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, matter is disposed of by granting liberty to the applicant to file representation praying for grant of family pension before the
