The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Affidavit of service filed, be kept with the record.

The applicant has prayed for a direction to the respondent authorities to offer him an employment under compassionate ground. The father of the applicant had expired while in service as a U.D.C. under the District Magistrate & Collector, Howrah on 31.07.2015. The mother of the applicant had submitted a plain paper application in favour of the applicant on 25.08.2015. It is submitted that despite such an application, the respondent authorities are yet to consider and intimate the decision to the applicant. The copy of the last representation was furnished by the applicant before the District Magistrate, Howrah on 25.09.2022. During the submissions of this matter, it has also been brought to notice of the Tribunal that the deceased employee had left behind legal heirs from his first wife, they may also be entitled for such an employment if they have applied. Attention of this Tribunal has also been drawn to the order passed by the District Magistrate on 24.03.2022 in which it is evident that the mother of this applicant, Krishna Maity (Ghosh) has been found to be entitled for pension and other retiral
