The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 536-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

This application is for an order for compassionate employment. After the death of her mother, Chandrabai Balmiki who died working as a sweeper in Uluberia Sub-Divisional Hospital, Howrah, the applicant submitted an application for compassionate employment to the Superintendent Sub-Divisional Hospital on 14.01.2019.

Learned advocate appearing on behalf of the Uluberia Municipality submits copies of documents supporting the applicant being the legal heir of the deceased employee. Submission is for a direction to the respondent to consider and dispose of her application for compassionate employment.

After hearing the learned advocates, the matter is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 2 & 6,

Superintendent of Uluberia S.D.Hospital, Howrah and CMOH, Howrah to submit complete proposal for compassionate employment on behalf of the applicant to the Director of Health Services, W.B. within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of this order. If the CMOH considers, if necessary, to call the applicant with supporting document, he shall do so and the applicant shall appear before the CMOH, Howrah.

Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
