The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer in this application relates to setting aside the impugned order dated 20.09.2022 passed by the Secretary, Animal Resources Development Department, Government of West Bengal relating to the compassionate employment of the applicant. The reasoned order passed by the respondent rejected the application for compassionate employment on the ground that the application does not fulfil certain requisite conditions.

Submission of Mrs. Roy, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant is that the respondent has failed to give a specific reason as to why the application for compassionate employment was ineligible and thus rejected. The reasoned order passed is devoid of any merit and is non est in the eyes of law.

Mr Ray, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that since the application did not fulfil the eligibility criteria

under relevant Rules, therefore, the application was turned down.

After hearing the submissions of the learned counsels and in particular, examining the reasoned order passed by the respondent dated 20.09.2022, it is clear that the rejection for compassionate employment was neither relied nor based on any specific rule and which criteria and under which Rule has not been fulfilled has not been mentioned.

The relevant para rejecting the application by the respondent is as under:

“ 5. And whereas, the Departmental Committee, on examination of the documents and considering the matter from all relevant aspects, made its observations / recommendations to the ARD Department. Based on the above exercise, the department has decided that present application for appointment on compassionate can not be granted as it does not fulfil the requisite conditions laid out by the Government of West Bengal for compassionate appointment.

6. Hence, the application of Sri Tushar Kanti Panda for appointment on compassionate ground is hereby declined and disposed of.”

As is abundantly clear from the above order that neither any specific reason nor any specific Government rule was cited and relied upon in rejecting this application. Therefore, this reasoned order is liable to be quashed and so it is quashed and set aside with a direction to the respondent No. 1, the Secretary, Department of Animal Resources Development to reconsider the application for compassionate

employment and pass a reasoned and speaking order after relying on specific Government rules / orders within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order and inform the same to the applicant within two weeks thereafter.

Accordingly, the application is disposed of.
