The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated $23^{\text {rd }}$ November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsel, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The applicant claiming to be the daughter of the deceased employee Ashok Saha, a delivery man died in harness on 11.05 . 2007 prays in this application for compassionate employment. Although, no document has been filed in this application to prove her being the daughter of the deceased employee, Ashok Saha. On the contrary, a correspondence dated 17.12.2019 signed by Welfare-cum-Administrative Officer and Ex-Officio Deputy Milk Commissioner states that Kalpana Saha, the widow is the only legal heir of Ashok Saha and there is no mention of any Jui Das in the service papers. Further, Jui Das has never made any application for compassionate employment.

Mr. S. Chatterjee, learned advocate for the applicant prays for liberty to file relevant documents by way of a supplementary affidavit by the next date.
