The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

With the consent of both the parties, matter has been taken up for hearing. .

The counsel for the applicant submits that the father of the applicant died in harness on 31.12.2006 at the age of 52 years who was working as a Fire Operator in the Fire & Emergency Services. Thereafter, in the year 2009 his mother Smt. Sima Sarkar applied for compassionate appointment for his son Debayan Sarkar. Counsel for the applicant submits that the respondent authority may be directed to expedite the process of compassionate appointment of Mr. Debayan Sarkar.

The counsel for the state respondent submits that the department has already considered the prayer of the applicant, Debayan Sarkar, son of the deceased employee and rejected the prayer under Clause 6(c)(c) and Clause 14 (a) of Labour Department Notification No. 251-Emp. dated 03.12.2013. Copy of those orders be kept with the record. The counsel for the respondent has also served the copies to the counsel for the applicant.

In view of the above, the application is disposed of with no
