Let the matter appear under the heading “Admission Hearing” on 8th February, 2022 to enable Mr. Bhattacharjee to take instruction regarding segregation of marks in Part-I and Part-II of the examination. Prima facie, since we find the advertisement was issued in 2019 and though it does not contain the number of vacancies, as the applicants had participated in the recruitment process and as it appears from the notice dated 30th September, 2021 that there are 7227 vacancies, the question regarding number of vacancies cannot be raised at this stage. The question of maintainability of the application raised by Mr. Bhattacharjee, regarding seeking leave to file single application, is kept open.
