In this application, the prayer is for direction to the respondent authority to sanction the pension after adding the past service as a casual worker to qualify for pension.

Mr. De, representing the department points out to the reply submitted by the respondent in which it appears that the applicant had only 3 years 7 months and 19 days qualifying service, thus, not eligible for pension. It is also pointed out that the representation of the applicant was also considered by the ADM & DL & LRO, Paschim Midnapore on 14.01.2021. In his order, the ADM & DL & LRO records that the applicant has served only 3 years 7 months and 3 days service since his appointment as a Group-D on regular basis was from 29.12.2000 and his services as Tehsil Mohuri was on casual basis, therefore, the past service cannot be counted. It also appears that the applicant has not challenged the order of ADM & DL & LRO, nor appealed against the order before the Appellate Authority.
