The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Learned advocate for the applicant submits that his applicant's father was Late Kalipada Sardar was a Gowala under Animal Resources Department, Government of West Bengal, prematurely died on 24.04.2010. Thereafter, application was submitted in prescribed format on time seeking compassionate employment with support from other family's members in the form of no objection certificate. It is submitted and also evident from the records that these papers were processed and the three men committee submitted its enquiry report to the Deputy Director, Animal Husbandary and Veterinary Services, Government of West Bengal with their recommendations.

Learned advocate for the applicant submits that the Director, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary, Government of West Bengal - the respondent no. 1 may be directed to dispose of the matter at the earliest.

Learned advocate for the State respondents submits that once such a direction is given suitable action will be taken by the respondent Case No. OA-910 of 2021.
