Heard the learned advocates.

“In this application, the applicant prays for setting aside of the impugned order dated 12.11.2020 rejecting the prayer for compassionate employment. The reason stated in the impugned order for rejection is that the applicant made an application for compassionate employment more than ten years after the death of the deceased employee. It appears from the record that the applicant was then a minor of 11(eleven) years old.

Mrs. Mitra submits that under the Scheme, the applicant has to apply within two years from the date of death of the deceased employee and in this case the application was made after more than ten (ten) years and thus, the application is not maintainable and may be disposed of. “

After hearing both the learned advocates and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is disposed of without any order. There is no dispute from the applicant's side that contrary to the rules existing then and now, the application was submitted after a lapse of 10 years. The

respondents were right in considering the application on this ground. Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
